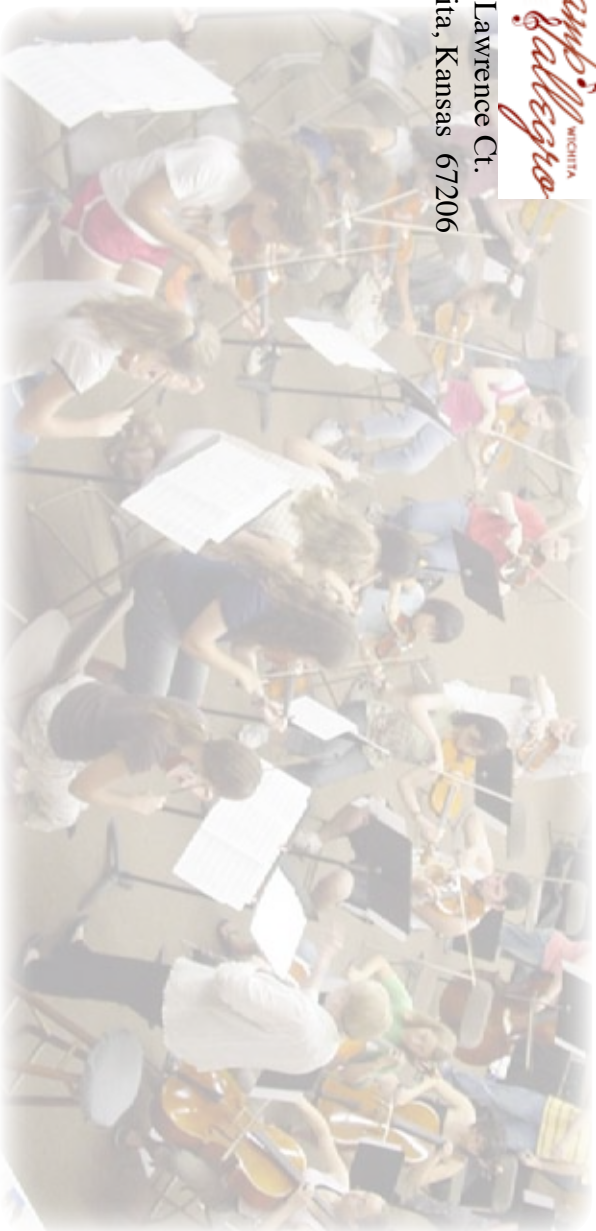

STRINGS

Violinists, violists, cellists and bassists play in small group ensembles (trios, quartets, string ensembles with piano, cello choir, etc.) as well as orchestra. The chamber ensembles are coached by our experienced teachers. Campers play in one of two orchestras; the advanced orchestra is conducted by Jacqueline Dillon and Dr. Mark Laycock, Wichita State University professors. Fiddling and jazz/blues improv are also available for string players.



WOODWIND AND BRASS

Campers who play band instruments will play in a small group ensemble with other wind and brass instrumentalists. They will also play in band and may choose to play in jazz band as well (at least two years of playing experience is required for jazz band).



BEGINNING INSTRUMENTS

Campers who do not currently play an instrument will sing in choir, take music theory and a beginning instrument(s), such as piano, violin, or guitar, and art or photography.

- * The location for Camp Allegro Wichita, as well as for placement auditions, is Immanuel Lutheran Church, 909 S. Market St.
- * Placement auditions for those who already play an instrument will be on May 15; you will be contacted about an audition time
- * Campers ages 7-18 will attend camp Monday-Friday from 9:00 AM-5:00 PM
- * Campers ages 7-18 will perform in concerts at the end of the camp day on Thursday and Friday
- * Campers ages 3-6 (Kinderlab) will attend camp Monday-Friday from 9:00-1:00 PM
- * Kinderlab campers will play in a concert on Friday at 12:30 PM
- * The cost for full day campers is \$190 and for Kinderlab is \$140; tuition includes a camp t-shirt
- * A non refundable \$50 deposit is due with the application on this brochure by May 6; the balance is due by June 10

KEYBOARD

Campers may elect to play piano as well as organ at Camp Allegro Wichita. Pianists are placed in piano ensembles (usually three or more players) and may play in a chamber music ensemble with other instrumentalists based on playing ability. Jazz band offers another performing opportunity for intermediate to advanced pianists.



CAMP MUSICA

Camp Musica offers advanced players of all instruments more emphasis on chamber music. Campers play in additional chamber music ensembles and in band or orchestra (pianists will sing in choir). Music theory and history classes are also offered. Private lessons may also be available for a small additional fee. Admission to Camp Musica is based on ability; campers of any age may apply. Placement will be determined by audition (at the regular audition time for Camp Allegro Wichita).



KINDERLAB

Kinderlab is our “camp within a camp” for children ages three to six. Kinderlab campers have the opportunity to try various instruments (violin, piano or recorder) and take part in large musical group activities. In addition, professional musicians demonstrate their instruments and play for the campers. Art, recreation and snacks round out the Kinderlab morning.
